Jesus sent them out into the storm, and built their faith stronger as a result (one was willing to step out of the boat).


As it relates to us and less resources, and empty chairs, we need to focus on the call of Jesus to us as his Church and the vision he has given us and not be distracted.

- 4. Building update Bids due from contractors this Friday. Our architect will review the bids for compliance with specifications and price competitiveness. We are expecting bids from 5 contracting firms. Expecting approval on site plan and building in the coming month.
- 5. Holy Week Schedule Maundy Thursday Agape Seder: 6:30 get your RSVPs in, Good Friday 7:30, Easter Sunday with baptisms and confirmations at 10 AM all at Willow Springs. Mailer invitations going out this weekend to 1500 homes surrounding the school. We should duplicate a sign for Braddock Road with the mailer graphics.
- 6. What's in a name? Discussion on our vision.
- 7. Confirm upcoming Vestry meetings 2017: 4/25, 5/23, Retreat May 12-13.
- 8. Other feedback when do we begin a fellowship time following our Sunday service (coffee hour?) We are too quick to take down the chairs and dismantle the meeting room. Staff will work with volunteers on a solution.
