- **Rector's Report on Multiethnic Conference in Dallas** - Joe reported that his time at the conference was very encouraging. There were many young speakers. It was impressed upon those attending the conference that the whole effort of creating multiethnic churches, and moving congregations through this process, is often more difficult than those involved anticipated.
